1. Always consult the MCTA website and your level coordinator for definitive advice regarding applicable policies and conditions.
2. Most League programs use a 3 doubles courts format. By national regulation, Adult League 2.5 and 5.0 level leagues play a format of 1 singles + 2 doubles, while all other Adult Division levels play 2 singles + 3 doubles. A level league may, by affirmative vote of 70% of the affected captains, vote to play the "small" format if it wishes. A level league that exercises this right recognizes that when they advance to championship play they will be required to follow the national format for that level.
3. National rules set minimum requirements for the number of players on a roster. MCTA elects to set specified maximum roster sizes. In the Spring Adult Leagues, roster min/max numbers are a function of the specific match format applicable to the playing level. The "small format" leagues are bound by the smaller roster size limits, while the "regular format" leagues are bound by the larger roster size limits.
4. The Initial Team Registration Deposit is required for a Captain to receive a Team Code, which is a necessary prerequisite to player registration. The deposit is equal to the cost of one team match and is refunded at the end of the local league season after adjusting for any default courts given or received over the course of local match play.
5. Per Player Fees are collected at the time of on-line registration via TennisLink and are subject to change without notice. Per Player Fees consist of: a Maryland District fee (currently \$20.00 for Adult, Senior, Senior Mixed, Super Senior, Winter Mixed leagues; \$12 for Super Duper Senior leagues; and \$9.00 for Super Senior Mixed Doubles, Fall Combo, Fall Mixed, and Winter Ladies Day leagues); an MCTA administrative fee of \$12.50 (\$6.50 for Senior leagues); and two non-refundable fees: a Mid-Atlantic Section fee of \$3.75, and the national TennisLink "user fee" (7.5% of registration fees plus \$0.50, \$3.00 minimum) that supports system maintenance and enhancement. *Note: Per Player Fees do not include court fees for league match play, or any other team fees that a Captain may assess.*
